3. Business & Compliance Implications

Modern organizations face dual pressures:

- Real-time supply chain monitoring.

5. Key Compliance Roles

Borrowing from GDPR Article 4 definitions, Persiv applies these roles across industries:

- Data Subject → Any individual whose personal or operational data is processed.
- Controller → The organization deciding how/why data is processed.
- Processor → Persiv (when operating in SaaS mode), providing compliant tools under the controller’s governance.

Example:

- In healthcare → Hospital (Controller), Patient (Data Subject), Persiv (Processor).
- In supply chain → Manufacturer (Controller), End-customer (Data Subject), Persiv (Processor).

Pseudonymization & Anonymization

Persiv supports both methods:

This ensures compliance with frameworks like GDPR Article 34, which relaxes notification requirements if strong encryption/pseudonymization is applied.

- Continuous monitoring with proactive alerts.
- Privacy by design/default embedded into system.
- Example (Supply Chain): Anomalous access attempt from outside expected geography triggers Persiv alert → incident workflow auto-initiated.

7.4 Report – Audit & Comply

- Automated compliance dashboards.
- Data subject request logs (access, correction, deletion).
- Audit trail exports in machine-readable formats.
- Support for region-specific compliance (EU data residency, HIPAA audit).

Example (Pharma): Clinical trial consent tracking logged automatically for audit submission to regulators.

8. Data Inventory & Mapping

- Collected Data: minimal – name, email, dashboard usage logs.
- Not Collected: financial data, health data, biometric data, or behavioral tracking beyond usage monitoring.
- Storage & Security: encrypted at rest and in transit, hosted securely in Persiv servers.
- Lifecycle: data created at account setup → processed for authentication & analytics → deleted upon license termination.
- Retention: usage logs retained for 90 days; identifiers retained while license is active.

- Data Minimization: identifiers stored only as long as required.

- Vendor register maintained with lawful basis for processing.
- GDPR-compliant DPAs required before sharing data.
- Vendors restricted from secondary use (e.g., marketing).
- Regular compliance reviews and audits (ISO 27001, SOC2)

12. Breach & Incident Response

- Response Plan: clear playbook, defined roles, escalation SLAs.
- Detection: real-time monitoring, intrusion prevention systems.
- Notification: regulators informed within 72 hours; users notified promptly.
- Remediation: incidents logged, corrective measures tracked, lessons integrated.
